POSITION OVERVIEW

1. Sweep, vacuum, wax, and mop the floor;
2. Sanitize restrooms;
3. Empty trash, recycling, and compost;
4. Clear snow in the winter and tend to grass/gardens in summer;
5. Wash windows, inside and outside;
6. Inspect and maintain ventilation and generator systems;
7. Make sure the establishment is clean and meets all safety requirements;
8. Wash walls, ceilings, and light fixtures regularly.

QUALIFICATIONS

9. A successful candidate will have the skills and qualifications to maintain a building safely and in accordance to Health and Safety Regulation Standards in Ontario;
10. Ability to use/operate industrial cleaning equipment or snow removal equipment;
11. Skills to make minor repairs (drywall repair, paint restorations, etc.);
12. Ability to work independently and demonstrate problem solving skills;
13. An understanding of health and safety regulations;
14. Ability to keep an organized record of cleaning supply inventory;
15. Ability to perform maintenance checks on the ventilation and generator system;
16. Possess a friendly and respectful demeanor at all times.

* Previous work experience, specifically in a Janitor role, is not always necessary. Any experience that demonstrates the candidate is hard-working, respectful of safety regulations, and attentive to detail is considered an asset.
